**1) Program:** Bachelor of Architecture (Batch 2016)

**2) Eligibility:**

2.1. Admission to Bachelor of Architecture (5 years) of the NMIMS will be based on the following two criteria:

I) Minimum 50% marks in 10+2 exam or equivalent in any stream from a recognized board at the first attempt with Mathematics and English compulsory.

(or)

10+3 Diploma (Any stream) recognized by Central/ State Governments with minimum 50% marks at the first attempt with Mathematics and English compulsory.

(or)

International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB certificate or / & DP awarded are **not eligible**) in any stream from a recognized Board with minimum 50% marks at the first attempt as a regular student Mathematics and English compulsory.

II) NATA Score (Minimum 80 out of 200)

2.2.1. The candidate must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination including International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB certificate or / & DP awarded are **not eligible**) in any stream from a recognized Board at the first attempt (Mathematics and English compulsory) and should have obtained a minimum of 50% marks at the said examination. Candidates who have not cleared the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the first attempt are NOT eligible to apply for the admission to the course.

Candidates passing 10+2 or equivalent examination in compartment are not eligible. Only single marksheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in first attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized marksheet will be considered.

Candidates passing 10+2 or equivalent examination from Open or Distance learning (ODL) School recognized only by National Institute of Open schooling (NIOS) can apply for the program subject to fulfilling the eligibility of the program & Candidates who have passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination by doing part-time course or through distance learning/correspondence/externally/open school other than NIOS are not eligible to apply for the courses.

- 2.2.2. Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 examination can also apply but they have to produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the stipulated time by the University
- 2.2.3. Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must Produce in writing from the Board/University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA obtained.
- 2.2.4 IB Candidates have to enter 'Predicted Scores' in case final grades/ marks are not declared. The Admission will be given on Provisional basis only. In case of Foreign Board, Candidate has to submit AIU equivalence Certificate at the time of Admission, if selected.
- 2.2.5 Candidate above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- 2.2.6 Candidates of CBSE, ICSE, Should mention in online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10th /10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all subjects for which candidate has appeared for (not best of Four, Five, Six or seven).
- 2.2.7 The candidates shall have passed all the subjects appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program.
- 2.2.8 Only single marksheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed is mandatory, no compartmentalized marksheet will be considered.
- 2.2.9 In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board/Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 2.2.10 International school/s candidates will have to submit AIU certificate of equivalence to confirm their eligibility for the program as equivalent to (10+2) examination/s.
- 2.2.11 Candidate whose final marksheet is not available at the time of admission are require to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school/college, failing which candidate will not be admitted.

**Note (for IB & Cambridge Candidate):** Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who have not received final marksheet till then will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted score. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed only on submission of final marksheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible. The candidate shall have to submit copy of AIU notification to confirm their eligibility for the program as equivalent to (10+2) examination/s.

**3) Duration of Course:** 5 Years

**4) Intake:** 40 seats

**5) Online Registration:**

Register online on website [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) and pay registration fee of Rs. 1600/- (non-refundable) (Please refer online registration for payment details)

**6) Selection Process:-**

- The merit list will be prepared on the basis of the application data in terms of academic marks at the 12<sup>th</sup> std. and NATA Score.
- The selection will be solely based on merit. In this regard, the decision of the NMIMS will be final and undisputable as also shall be binding on all concerned.
- Candidates are advised to visit the NMIMS website [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) to know the details of selection process.

**7) Program Fees:**

Fees for Batch-2015-16: Rs. 4, 00, 000/- (for information only)

Fees for the current year will be intimated at the time of admission.

**8) Refund Rules:**

The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows:

1. Till the date of commencement of the Programme. (till <b>18<sup>th</sup> July 2016</b> )	Rs.1000/- will be deducted as administrative charges
2. After the commencement of Programme but before the close of the admission. ( <b>19<sup>th</sup> July 2016 to 30<sup>th</sup> July 2016</b> )	Rs.1000 + Proportionate fees i.e. one tenth of the fees for every completed month or part thereof, if the seat vacated by the candidate is filled. If the seat remains vacant /unfilled fees will <b>NOT</b> be refunded.
3. Cancellation after the official Closure of admission. ( <b>31<sup>st</sup> July 2016 onwards</b> )	Cancellation made after the official closing of admission fees will <b>NOT</b> be refunded.

**9) Important Instructions:**

- 1) Candidates will have to apply to the NMIMS and should also apply separately to NATA for taking their aptitude test. For further details of the test visit [www.nata.in](http://www.nata.in) and [www.coa-india.org](http://www.coa-india.org)
- 2) Merit list will be prepared on the basis of 12<sup>th</sup> Marks & Valid NATA Score entered at the time of Online Registration. Therefore, it is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.
- 3) At any given point of time it is found that the information given by candidate i.e 12<sup>th</sup> Marks or Valid NATA Score is incorrect, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- 4) Please note that the registration fee is non- refundable.

- 5) Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the NMIMS will be through its web site [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) and no individual communication will be sent to the candidate. Kindly check website for regular updates
- 6) It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check whether he/she is eligible for the program as per the eligibility criteria stated above.
- 7) Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate
- 8) Candidates are required for admission process in person.
- 9) Candidate's documents will be verified at the time of admission (if selected) & if found not eligible admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited
- 10) NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible. No separate intimation will be given in that regard.
