1. <u>Introduction</u>:

The NMIMS's Balwant Sheth School of Architecture (BSSA) aims at a diversified model of education, where besides the core training of an architect, a student is given exposure to a range of allied and parallel disciplines and practices. 2. <u>Duration of the programme</u>: Minimum o3 years including course work & Maximum o6 years.

4. <u>Eliqibility and Admission Criteria</u>:

The Master's degree should be passed with at least 55% marks in aggregate OR its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 – point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is allowed)

A) Ph.D. in Architecture: (Full time and Part time)

- 1) Bachelor's degree in Architect or equivalent and Master's degree in architecture / allied Specialization or equivalent from any recognized institution.
- 2) Bachelor's degree in Architecture or equivalent in first class with 10-year experience in teaching / research / professional practice.

OR

 An equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

B) Certificate Progrmme in Architecture Research Studies:

- 1) Bachelor's degree in Architect or equivalent and Master's degree in architecture / allied Specialization or equivalent from any recognized institution.
- 2) Bachelor's degree in Architecture or equivalent in first class with 10-year experience in teaching / research / professional practice.

OR

- An equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and
 Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or
 incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the
 purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.
- A) Candidates working in Industry at an executive or supervisor capacity will be preferred. Full time experience would be considered and should NOT include part time experience, Internship, projects, training period, and trainee –etc.
- B) Candidates working in reputed Research Organizations or Academic Institutions, situated in the close vicinity of Mumbai campus are eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme if they satisfy the conditions mentioned below-
 - Candidates working in an organization, which encourages and facilitates research.
 - The Academic Institution should have at least one running PG programme in any specialization.
 - Candidates should have a minimum of two years of work experience (full time) in research organization, academic institutions or Industry.
 - Candidates should furnish a 'Consent and No Objection Certificate' from his / her Academic
 Institution and 'MOU' in case of industry or research organization.

Note:

- Candidates appearing or waiting for the final year of their programme are eligible to apply. However their admission would be considered provisional, subject to their meeting the minimum eligibility criteria after their final qualifying examination results are announced.
- The candidate must have appeared for all his subject(s) / exams before the commencement of the respective program/s of NMIMS (Deemed to be University). The examination of any of the subjects must not be held after the commencement of the respective course. Also the candidate should be declared pass in all the above referred subjects (s) / examinations by the University where from he / she is graduating, with minimum stipulated marks in the aggregate. However, in case the candidates whose graduating University schedules the final year / semester / trimester examination/s (as applicable) during /

- after the commencement of the respective program, such candidates' candidature may be considered subject to NMIMS discretion.
- Candidates who have cleared their graduation by doing a part-time course or through distance learning, correspondence courses, externally, open school from recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.
 - All admitted students will have to complete Ph. D. course work as prescribed by the SVKM's NMIMS
 (Deemed to be University). On successful completion of Ph.D. course work student will be eligible for
 registration for Ph.D. programme.
- All candidates applying for part time Ph.D. in Architecture are required to submit NOC (No objection certificate) from the employer.

7. Call letter & Upload of Documents:

Candidates who are registered successfully will be called for Entrance Test and Personal Interview. They can check / download their call letter from login dashboard and upload below mentioned document using the link given in application form / call letter before the deadline.

- Attested copies of Graduation Mark sheet (All Years) and Degree Certificate (Convocation certificate)
- Attested copies of Post-Graduation Mark sheet (All Years) and Degree Certificate (Convocation certificate)
- UGC-NET (including JRF)/UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/SLET/GATE/GPAT examination or other equivalent examinations certificate (if appeared)
- Statement of Purpose (Format attached). SOP should described "Area of Research"
- Work Experience certificate (as applicable for Industry / Research Institutes / Academic Institute candidates) (If the work experience certificate is in more than one company a separate work experience certificate signed by the employer stating clearly the nature of work experience is to be submitted. The work experience certificate must contain the date of joining, designation, date of relieving (if applicable) and the level at which the designation is covered in the organization. If the current designation or the designation at the time of leaving the organization (as applicable) is/was different than the designation at the time of joining then in such case candidate must provide the copy of the appointment letter.

It is important and primary requirement to upload the mandatory documents before Entrance Test

No Candidate will be permitted to attend admission test unless he / she uploads the application along
with SOP in time AND completes the selection process successfully.

8. <u>1) Selection Process for Ph.D. in Architecture: (Full time and Part time)</u>

The candidate must have passed Entrance Admission Test conducted by NMIMS University.

OR

The candidate has qualified UGC-NET (including JRF) / UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF) / SLET / GATE / GPAT examination of the apex bodies in higher/technical professional education or other equivalent examination.

A) Entrance Test (Time: 90 minutes / Total: 100 Marks), will be conducted at Mumbai campus only.

Section A: 50% of Research Methodology

Section B: 50% Area / Domain Specific

The candidate must have qualified entrance test with qualifying marks as 50% conducted by the NMIMS University. Only entrance test qualified candidate would be called for Personal Interview process.

NOTE: The candidate qualified in UGC-NET (including JRF) / UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF) / SLET / GATE / Teacher Fellowship holder or have passed M.Phil. Programs are exempted from NMIMS entrance test. However, they have to appear for Personal Interview.

B) Personal Interview (Total 30 Marks)

- Personal Interview will be held at Mumbai campus only.
- Presentation based on SOP will be followed by Personal Interview
- During interview candidates are expected to discuss their research Interest / area
- Final merit list will be based on entrance Test & Personal Interview marks.

C) Weightage

Entrance Test : 100 marks (70%)
 Personal Interview : 50 marks (30%)

- PhD student will not be entitled to avail of the scholarship if he/she re-registers for PhD or take readmission for the PhD program.

- Candidate has to check the website for all details. Please check the important dates. All
 announcements from the SVKM's NMIMS (Deemed to be University) will be through its website
 www.nmims.edu
- For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal/cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by the candidate for any reason. Candidate has to upload cancellation form duly filled and signed, fees paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account) to mentioned link: https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation/
- The candidate who is pursuing PhD at SVKM's NMIMS (Deemed to be University), should not take PG / PhD admission in any other University.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/ her in the application form is incorrect, his/her application for the admission to the program, even if selected, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per SVKM's NMIMS (Deemed to be University) refund rules.

 provisional admission, is required to submit their final marksheet copy as soon as the result declared. In
 such case, if the candidate fail to meet the required eligibility criteria then his/her admission will be
 cancelled and the fees will be refunded as per SVKM's NMIMS (Deemed to be University) refund rules.
- Admission to program is considered as "Provisional Admission" till all required and mandatory
 documents are submitted by the candidate and the same are verified and approved. If it is found that
 the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be
 cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses even if selected/ admitted to the
 program.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
- All matters of dispute will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Mumbai only.

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Format for preparing SOP

Title: The Title of the project should be concise (with sub-title, if any) reflecting the scope of the investigation.

Aim of the Project: The broad Aim of the project emphasizing the overall thrust of the proposed investigation should be clearly mentioned.

Statement of the Problem: The problem to be investigated should be clearly contextualized in the theoretical framework of the discipline.

Overview of Literature: The problem identified should be logically linked to other studies on the theme in the literature delineating the need for the present investigation.

Conceptual Framework: The concepts to be used, their relevance and applicability to the study and their operationalization should be indicated.

Research Questions or Hypotheses: The research questions to be answered/ addressed need to be unequivocally stated.

Research Methodology:

- (a) Coverage: The proposal should clearly indicate the universe of the study, sampling frame, sampling methods, sampling size, units of observation etc.
- **(b) Data Collection:** The proposal should indicate sources of data types of data, tools and techniques for collection of various categories of proposed data.
- (c) Data Analysis: It should indicate the statistical techniques, if any, proposed to be used in data processing, specific packages for data analysis, content analysis, indices/scaling techniques proposed to be used etc.

Implications: The proposal should state whether this research would bring forth any implications for policy making either for the region concerned or the country, any methodological innovations or contribute to theory building.

References: The proposal should include a 'List of References' mentioned in the text along with other important recent additions to the literature on the theme. The references should indicate the author, title, publisher and year of publication.
