Q.1 What is the focus of B.Arch. Program at BSSA?

Q.4 What is the eligibility for B.Arch. Program?

For B. Arch. the candidate must have passed 10+2 scheme of examination with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination (or) 10+3 Diploma (Any stream) recognized by Central, State Governments with minimum 50% marks at the first attempt with Mathematics and English compulsory.

Q.5 What is the admission process for enrolment into B.Arch. program?

Step 1 : Apply for B.Arch Program @ www.bssa.nmims.edu

Step 2 : Update your 10+2 examination / NATA / JEE (Paper-II) marks

The Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the application data in terms of academic marks at the 10+2 examination and NATA Score / Aptitude Test conducted by Competent Authority of Central / State Government (Including JEE Paper- II Aptitude Test in Architecture).

Q.6 Do IB students have a different process?

No, IB Students must follow the same admission procedure.
