#### I. Preamble

The BoS then deliberates the curriculum changes and forwards it to the Academic Council at University level for its approval. The Academic Council approves the changes which are then endorsed by the Board of Management/Executive Council and the changes are implemented in the curriculum from the forthcoming session.




