Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch.) - Transfer of admission in Second year against Vacant seats

Information Handout

1) Introduction: This Handout gives information about the transfer of admission in 2nd year against vacant seats of Bachelor of Architecture (Batch 2020). Transfer of admission, only if vacant seats are available.

2) Eligibility:

- Candidate should be passed in all subjects of first year of B Arch program
- Candidate should have below mentioned documents / attested copy:
 - (a) B. Arch. First year (Semester 1 and Semester 2 marksheet)
 - (b) No Objection Certificate from previous college
 - (c) No Objection Certificate from Council Architecture (COA)
 - (d) SSC Marksheet & Passing certificate
 - (e) HSC Marksheet & Passing certificate
 - (f) NATA / JEE Score card
 - (g) Leaving certificate
 - (h) Migration Certificate (for outside Maharashtra state candidate only)
 - (i) Transcript (for IB Board only)
 - (j) AIU Certificate (for IB board only)
 - (k) GAP certificate (if applicable)
 - (I) Medical Fitness Certificate

4) Selection Process:-

• The Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the application data in terms of academic marks at the B. Arch. – First year examination only.

• The selection will be solely based on merit. In this regard, the decision of the NMIMS will be final and undisputable as also shall be binding on all concerned.

5) Program Fees:

Fees for Batch-2019-20: Rs. 5,01,000/- per year (for information only)

Fees for the current year will be intimated at the time of admission.

6) Refund Rules: The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule October 2018:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 3 rd August 2020)
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. (4th August 2020 to 19th August 2020)
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (20th August 2020 to 3 rd September 2020)
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (4th September 2020 to 18th September 2020)
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (19th September 2020 onwards)

*(Inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit) In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable).

7) Important Instructions:

- Candidates will have to apply to the NMIMS and should also apply separately to NATA for taking their aptitude test. For further details of the test visit www.nata.in and www.coa-india.org
- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of B Arch First year examination. Therefore, it is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does **not** satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect i.e B Arch First year examination or any

other information, his/her admission to the course, even if selected, will stand cancelled and fees will be forfeited.

- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the NMIMS will be through its web site www.nmims.edu and no individual communication will be sent to the candidate. Kindly check website for regular updates.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for the admission to the courses at NMIMS.
